I was already familiar with the warm culture and supportive learning environment at Tameside College.

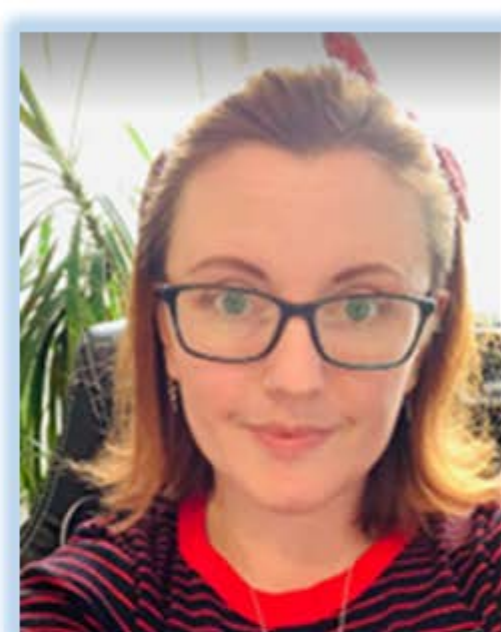
The staff were incredibly supportive and they really care about all of their learners.
